## Your Library Your Way

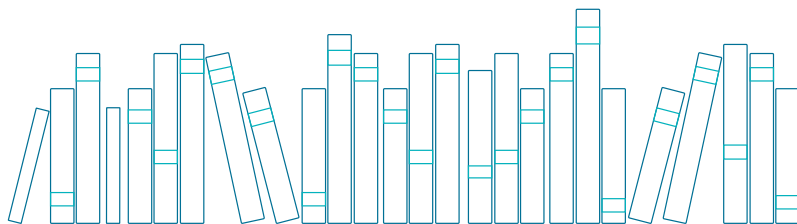
Librarians work in close consultation with academic staff and students to provide a highly personalised service to support learning, teaching and research activities.

## Intellectual Property

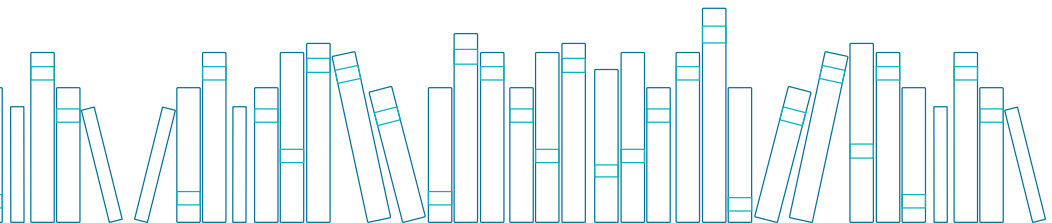
Librarians provide copyright compliance information with in-depth advice and training available through the Manager, Scholarly Publications and Copyright.

# RESOURCES

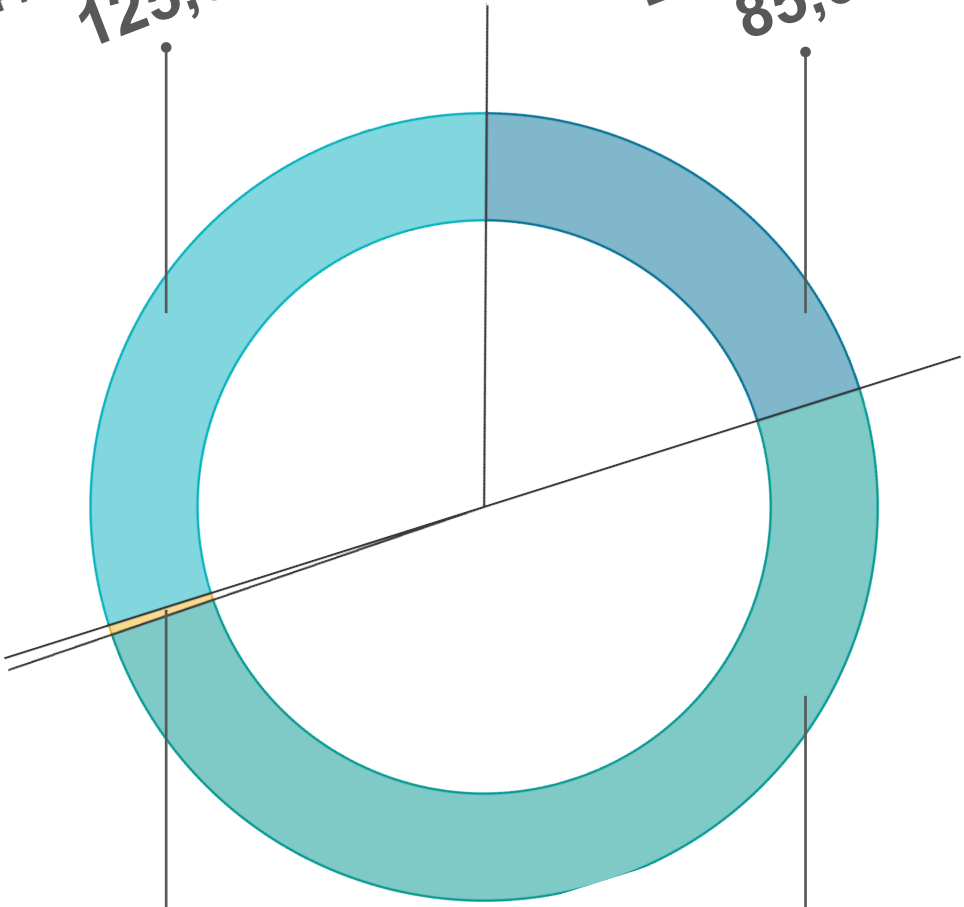

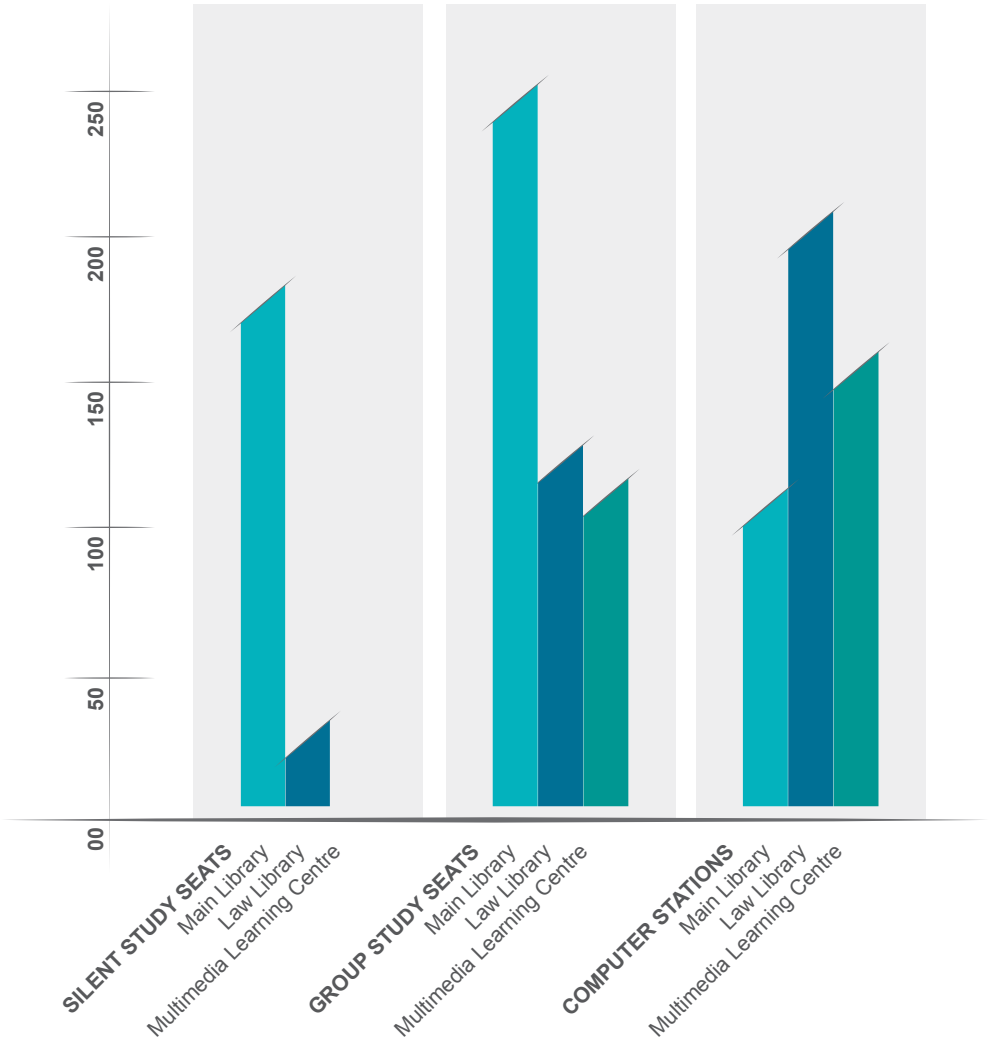
